- Looked like a blue tarp couldn't tell for sure it was covered with tree branches. Maybe a wiki up? - El Manto
- Camp site set up in a dredger hold. South of the white water tank east of the gate by boat launch at the end of Rossmoor Bar
- There are still several homeless camps on the south side of the American river just west of the power lines between Howe and Watt avenue
- Wikiup made out green tarps. Gear hanging in the trees around the camp site. Riverbend
- Signage has been changed to allow bikes on trail that is not designated for bikes. Signage changes do not appear to have been made by Park personnel.
- Illegal dumping/driving on/fires on Mather Preserve
- We have witnessed a gentleman leave trash for the animals/birds on several occasions. He also strips naked and washes himself in the American River - Hoffman
- Constant ATV and motorcycle use on the bike trail and surface streets accessing the trail in and around Depot Park and the rodeo area. Dry Creek Parkway

- Toyota Pickup, Yellow with primer on fenders, whenever that truck is in Rossmoor Bar Parking lot there seems to be hobo activity moving and hanging around the parking lot.
- Abandoned illegal camp sites Howe to Watt, South of River
- About 4 abandoned illegal camp sites in the parkway area behind my home - Howe to Watt
- Camp site going up down in the big ravine off main road -Riverbend
- Camp site set up. Blue tarps or tent. Yellow looking pit bull running loose around camp site - El Manto
- There is an increase in mountain bikes on the Equestrian Trail.
 East of Watt Ave to William Pond
- 3 homeless camps just west of the power lines between Watt Ave and Howe Ave
- 3 Illegal Camp near entrance of Camp Pollock
- Suspected illegal camper looking for campsite in Parkway at Gristmill Park
- Homeless, Shopping Carts, Graffiti, human waste, sleeping in park, drugs - Carmichael Park
- HUGE illegal camp set-up in the wilderness area leading into Camp Pollock
- Down from the parking lot at Gristmill and to the right are 3 wooden pallets, one on shore are 2 just offshore

- Vast homeless populations destroying the American River parkway – Howe at water treatment plant
- Green Tent set up in Rossmoor Bar area
- Saw on the ground 4 or 5 sleeping bags, 3 or 4 backpacks Riverbend
- 2 illegal camps on horseshoe trail Camp Pollock
- Camp site 150 yards, west of the blue dumpster Riverbend

- Homeless Camp with dozens of needles. 1/2 mile upstream from Kadema
- Multiple homeless encampments and trash along rivers edge, north shoreline, upstream from Business I-80
- Someone is digging an area under an oak tree on the side of the dry wash – Riverbend
- Off road motor vehicles, discharging weapons on vernal pool lands – Mather
- Two large homeless encampments are located along the river's edge and on an island – Sutter's Landing
- A couple of transients appear to have settled in to the river bank. Two bikes and a pile of stuff – Upstream of Estates
