



## More About Mather Golf Course

Mather Golf Course is located on the southeast portion of Sacramento in Mather Regional Park, Mather, California. The course was designed by Jack Fleming and built by the U.S. Air Force for exclusive use by the military. The first nine holes opened in 1958 with the second nine opening in 1963. The County purchased the golf course from the Air Force as part of the nationwide base closure process and opened it for public play in May 1994.

The facility includes a 6,700 square foot clubhouse including a fully stocked golf shop and restaurant with covered outside seating. The outside facilities include a driving range, practice bunkers, putting and chipping greens as well as an extra hole reserved for practice and a teaching area.

The Golf Shop is a full service operation with the latest in golf equipment and accessories. Mather Golf Course is also the home of the Getbetter Learning Center, staffed by training instructors that teach golfers of all ages and skill levels how to improve and enjoy the game. This golf course offers many league opportunities and a large assortment of tournament opportunities.

Mather Golf Course is managed by CourseCo Inc. for the County of Sacramento under a Professional Management Services Agreement that includes all operations: Golf course, Restaurant and Maintenance.
