Subject: Endorse The 2026 Department of Regional Parks Fee Schedule

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Endorse the 2026 Department of Regional Parks Fee Schedule.

BACKGROUND

The Department Fee Schedule establishes fees for park entry and facility use, and describes fee policies. The Fee Schedule is updated intermittently to:

- Adjust fees for inflation
- Ensure fees cover costs of services provided,
- Standardize fees with similar facilities and services,
- Raise revenues needed to offset department maintenance and operations costs.

Daily parking and annual pass fees were last updated in 2021. The latest major revision to the Department's Fee Schedule was approved by the Board of Supervisors in 2024.

The proposed revisions include increases to the following fees:

- Daily Parking
- Park Block Parking Permit
- Picnic site rentals
- Gibson Ranch House
- Gibson Ranch Cabins
- Special Instruction Program Permit
- Cherry Island Sports Complex Rental
- Vendor Fees
- Special Event Permit (1000 +participants)
- RV Camping (Sherman Island only)

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These fees have been increased to adjust for inflation, and to ensure fees cover the cost of staffing for services provided.

Staff compiled the daily vehicle, daily boat launch, and annual pass fees charged by other comparable park agencies with similar facilities to ensure that the proposed revisions to our fee schedule are within the range of fees charged by these agencies. Table 1 summarizes the fees charged by these agencies, compared to the proposed fee increase.

There are changes proposed for golf course fees, but these proposed changes are within the Director's delegated authority. As per Resolution No. 2000-0828, the Director is authorized to approve golf course fee changes up to a ceiling which is adjusted annually by the U.S. Department of Labor's Consumer Price Index (CPI) for February of each year and downward to not less than 10% of permanent pricing levels. Parks staff, in conjunction with the golf fee managers, annually assess the Golf Fee Schedule and adjust fees in accordance to the Director's authorization.

Habitat Restoration Program fees which are charged per acre of parkland area required for mitigation projects (based on the mitigation type) are not proposed to change at this time. These fees require a more complex evaluation, and the Department will utilize the services of a consultant to review these fees and bring any recommended changes to the Board at a future date.

FINANCIAL ANALYSIS

Additional revenues generated by increased fees will be accounted for in future budget years. The Department utilizes a three year average to determine the amount of day use, annual pass and special event revenues to be included in the budget each year.
