- **Other Incidents**
 - Rangers responded to a death investigation on the Northern Bike Trail by Elkhorn Blvd. The investigation was turned over to the Sacramento Sheriff's Department and it is being treated as a homicide.

 - Rangers conducted a death investigation along the American River Parkway between Rossmoor and El Manto river access. This death appeared to be a suicide. Rangers assisted with a death investigation by Northgate and 160. A body was pulled from the river with no obvious signs of trauma or foul play. Sacramento Police and coroner's office investigating.

 - Rangers assisted the Sacramento Sheriff's Department with a sex offender registration compliance check. The focus was along the American River Parkway and adjoining neighborhoods. The multi-agency team made approximately 25 arrests during the sweep for warrants as well as fresh charges for criminal activity.

 - Rangers responded to River Bend Park at the raft take out for a disturbance between rafters and a kayaker. The reporting person reported a person in a raft pointed a handgun at the kayaker. Sacramento Sheriff also responded to assist with units and the

helicopter. The weapon was recovered and the suspect was arrested for a variety of crimes including possession of a stolen firearm as well as possession of a concealed loaded firearm.

We have changed the format for tracking our illegal camping data. We will now be tracking the total number of illegal camps cleared, total number of illegal camping citations, and amount of debris removed from Regional Parks.
