• Parkway Watch Reports -23 reports

- Someone has dumped trash in the parkway including a burned up motorcycle engine and a refrigerator – Dry Creek Parkway
- Large. growing, garbage & illegal camps (looks like 5-8 people each side of river or more) with fires - under north and south low river banks under Hwy 160
- Illegal camps under I-5 being set up start of Two Rivers Trail
- There is a large tree that has fallen across the creek. It is about 1/4 mile north of Q Street in Rio Linda.
- Two men were climbing oak trees just east of the parking lot on Dry Creek Road. They were using ropes and were about 50 feet off the ground.
- I see huge piles of items the homeless dump on the S. shoulder of Garden Hwy. You can see huge camps all along Steelhead Creek between Garden Hwy,
- Suitcase, duffle bag and lunch pail left just off the levee. No one in sight Mayhew drain levee
- A tree is down and blocking the equestrian trail 200 yards west of the freeway along mile 4.

- Black Tarps made into a big domed shelter. A gazillion bike tracks on the trails around there - Rossmoor
- I have located 8 illegal camps Howe Ave to Watt Ave
- At mile 15.5 right on the river off the equestrian trail at Hagan Park on the far west edge of the park, there is a hammock nailed to a tree
- Illegal camping/Drug activity on the south side of the river just east of the Howe Avenue Bridge
- Large tent/hobo encampment on river's edge near Milepost 5
- Illegal camping off American River Bike trail near Northgate
- All the garbage cans are gone from the bike trail in the Dry Creek Parkway
- 4 illegal camps Northgate Blvd. Entrance to Camp Pollock Horseshoe Trail
- Bathroom floor usually wet and smells bad upon entering. Local males visiting Park are usually in both bathrooms, no Gender marked. Mckinley Park - Sacramento City
- Large pile of trash from illegal camp site visible from the bike trail –
 Ambassador
- There is a large homeless camp (and growing) near the south side of the American River just west of the power lines at the Glenbrook Park river access
- Vehicle driving in Mather preserve
- Tents and at least one male observed on the North side of the river west of Watt Ave. bridge.
- Camp site made with blue tarps. I think over a tent Riverbend
