## Parkway Watch Reports -22 reports

- Very large camp with lots of trash. Mile 4
- A very large, (over 100 year old), oak tree has fallen across the foot path between Bannister Park and the Sunrise foot bridge.
- A cache of homeless belongings and a possible camp –Howe, South of River
- Illegal Camp The camp is located at Sutters Landing near the banks of the river
- The star thistle is encroaching on the kayak launching trail at Sutter's Landing Park so badly that it's hard to get down the trail.
- At Sutter's Landing Park where we witnessed no less than a dozen off-leash dogs and several people drinking alcohol at the river.
- There is a bold illegal camp right next to the main trail (kayak launching trail) heading down to the river at Sutter's Landing Park. There is a male and female in the camp.
- Dry Creek Parkway Illegal camp. This is the third time this site has been reported over the last two months

## Ranger Activity Report June 2015

- Multiple homeless camps between Howe Avenue and the Fairbairn Water Treatment Facility on the south side of the river
- I was at the Mather Lake & park Saturday 20th and noticed a young goose (gosling) with a fish hook in its mouth with the line hanging down. It seemed to be in distress
- Illegal camper at Howe has moved large branches to block hiking trail on both sides of his camp and consistently has camp fires
- Debris from active or inactive illegal camping in the Sacramento Bar Area
- Feral cat colony feeding on Two Rivers Trail near 160 Bridge. Cat food is spread out along the trail and 1/2 gallon containers of milk have been cut open and left out to curdle
- Illegal camping in the parkway. Between Howe and Watt, South of river.
- 3 dogs off-leash at Hoffman.
- Large oak tree fallen with property damage to residence backyard fence -Rossmoor
- Around mile marker 3.5 on the American River Bike Trail, there are a number of turtles on or near the paved path.
- There is a male in his 50's and a young boy perhaps 15 or 16 years old that have been living on the west side of the Hayer Park bridge.
- There is a campsite just south of the Hayer Park bridge. There are two to four people.
- There is an 18"by24" hole in the deck of the bridge crossing over the Mayhew Drain near the river
- A lounge chair was illegally dumped in the park. Waterton Access
- Bikes on hiking / equestrian trail William Pond
- Off-leash dogs Hoffman
- An illegal campfire on the banks of the American River started a grass fire –
  Sutter's Landing
- Abandoned or active homeless camp/belongings Watt/Howe south of river
